Eunice Bolling Blackmon, age 84, born and raised in Perdido Alabama was a life-long resident of Bay Minette Alabama. She passed away peacefully at her home on Thursday, August 15, 2024. Eunice was retired from the Baldwin County Judicial Court System, having served as the Circuit Clerk of Baldwin County. She graduated from Perdido Jr. High and Baldwin County High Schools, then later earned a Secretarial Science degree at William Yancey (Coastal Community) State Jr. College.

Eunice was a devoted Christian having received Christ at a very young age. She served her Lord singing in the choir, teaching Sunday School and Children's Church in her home church of Perdido Church of God, as well as teaching and serving as the church treasurer at the Vision Ministries Church of God in Bay Minette. Eunice witnessed and testified of Jesus' saving grace and mercy to everyone she came in contact with, even up until the time of her earthly departure. In her spare time, she loved traveling, growing roses, growing and canning vegetables and making homemade jellies. Her inspiration in her later years was helping to raise her four granddaughters and two great-grandsons.
