Richard "Lulu" Lewis Williamson, Jr., age 58, of Atmore, Alabama, passed away on Friday, March 20, 2026. He was born on February 3, 1968, in Wetumka, Oklahoma, and carried with him a proud Mvskoke (Creek) heritage throughout his life.

Lulu was a man of quiet strength who loved his family. He wasn't one for a lot of words, but he had a great sense of humor and loved to laugh. He enjoyed telling stories that could bring a smile to your face, often filled with cultural knowledge and memories of days gone by.

In his younger years, Lulu was athletic, enjoyed playing basketball and volleyball, and was described as being "light on his feet" despite his size. As his health declined over time, he came to rely on a scooter—but that didn't slow him down much. His scooter had more than one speed, but Lulu really only used two: turtle or rabbit, and more often than not, it was rabbit. He was known to come flying through the door—more than once knocking it clean off the hinges—something that became just another one of those stories his family will always laugh about.

Lulu worked as a security guard during his working years and took pride in being watchful and observant. He enjoyed being outdoors, fishing, and spending time with those around him. He was an avid Alabama fan, liked

shooting pool, and was known by many as the “Lawnmower Man” for his ability and willingness to fix lawnmowers for others.

He loved playing ball with his dog, Gracie, traveling, and attending powwows. He was active in traditional Creek ceremonies and loved to stomp dance. Music was also a big part of his life—he enjoyed singing, listening to music, and could sometimes be found dancing in the backyard. His voice and songs will be deeply missed.

Lulu also appreciated good food and never passed up a buffet, especially Chinese food, which he enjoyed often.

He was preceded in death by his father, Richard Ralph Williamson, Sr.; his mother, Wanda Lowe; his daughter, Ariel Nason; his brothers, Curtis Williamson and Gordon “Chip” Williamson; and his nephew, Zachary Williamson.

Lulu is survived by his loving wife, Shelly Williamson of Atmore, Alabama; his daughter, Anjelika Williamson of Wewoka, Oklahoma; his stepdaughters, Meghann Hurt (Phillip) of Colorado and Kaitlynn Hubert (Nate) of Pennsylvania; his brother, Christopher “Ding Ding” Blackburn of Atmore, Alabama; his uncle, Thomas Lowe of Hannah, Oklahoma; along with numerous grandchildren, nieces, nephews, a great-niece, a great-nephew, and many extended family members and friends who will miss him deeply.
