Mr. Troy Eugene Byrd, age 89, passed away Monday, February 24, 2020 in Fairhope, Alabama.

Mr. Byrd was a native of Oak Grove, FL and had resided in Atmore, AL for the past 64 years. He was a member of the Carney Masonic Lodge #549 of Atmore, AL and the First Baptist Church of Atmore. He was owner and operator of Troy Byrd Water Well Service, a veteran of the US Army serving in the Korean Conflict with the 101st Air Borne Screaming Eagles, retiring with over 26 years with the Army and Alabama National Guard. He was honored with the National Defense Service Medal, the Good Conduct Medal, the Army Reserve Component with 2 Oak Leaf Clusters, the Faithful Service Ribbon of Alabama with 2 Saint Andrews Crosses and Special Service Medal of Alabama. 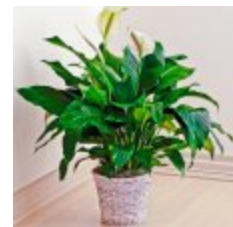
